
PAS Programme 2025-26 & Other Events



Our 2025-26 lecture programme is now all set and ready for the start of the new PAS session in September. We will tell you more about each of the speakers and their talks in future issues of this newsletter, but we hope you agree that we have an interesting and varied series ahead of us.

In addition to these monthly talks, we are trying something new this year. We have hired the Eastgate Theatre in Peebles for a public lecture by Dr Matthew Knight, senior curator of prehistory at National Museums Scotland. On Thursday 16th October, Matt and his conservator colleagues will be talking about **Unearthing & Conserving the Peebles Hoard**, 'one of the remarkable hoards ever found in Scotland'. Discovered locally in June 2020 during the Covid lockdown and dating to the Late Bronze Age (c.1000-800 BCE), the hoard contains several hundred elements from a complex set of bronze, leather and wooden objects, as well as a sword in a scabbard. Many of the objects have never been found before in Scotland. Conservation of this material is revealing fascinating stories about these objects, leading to intriguing questions about the people who made and buried them.

We hope this fascinating talk will attract a wider local interest in archaeology, potentially encourage some new members and for the Society to raise funds towards current and future field projects. Tickets cost £15 (sorry - no concessions!) and are available now from Eastgate Theatre. Please support this event and encourage friends and family to come along too.
